


Change the Browser Title using Yoast SEO plugin

1. Open up your Post
2. Scroll below the post (or to the place where the Yoast options display on your screen).
3. You will see Yoast's prediction about how your post will display in Google. (If you have not changed it yet, the title should be the same as your post's title.)
4. Click the Edit Snippet button, and, the area will expand.
5. You might see a number of fuschia-colored buttons. You can delete them and then add them back—in any order you want.
6. First, enter the title that you want. Then click the Insert Snippet Variable button to insert any of the pre-set information that you might want.
7. Scroll up, Update the post, and view it.
8. Rinse and repeat until you are happy with the browser title and how it displays.
